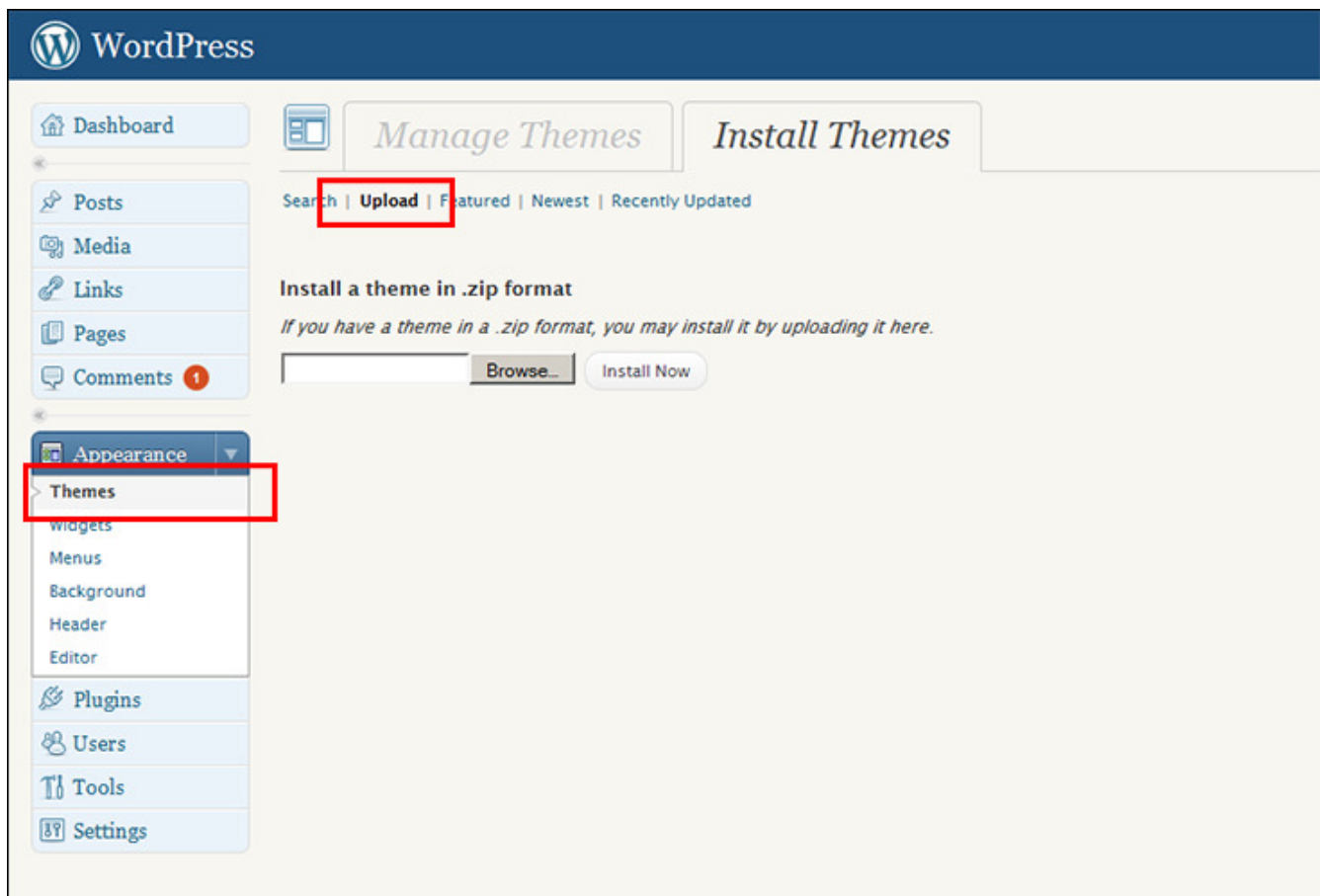

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Go to your WordPress Backend.
2. Open **Appearance** → **Themes** → **Install Themes**
3. Navigate to **Upload**
4. Browse for **.zip** file on your local computer, and **Install** it.
5. Then go to back to **Appearance** → **Themes**, and **Activate** theme



Got an error during installation process?

- disable all your plug-ins and try installing the theme again,
- make sure you are running the latest recommended version of WordPress
- try uploading the theme manually via FTP, into the folder `/wp-content/themes/`

CUSTOM MENUS

1. Go to **Appearance** → **Menus**
2. Create your own menus, using Categories, Pages and/or Custom Links
3. Specify your custom menus for **Theme Locations**

POST INSTALLATION STEPS

1. A new menu will appear in your Dashboard – **WPZOOM**. From this menu you will be able to configure **Themes Options**.
2. Navigate to **Appearance** → **Widgets** and add widgets to your theme.

Logo Image URL You can upload your own logo via [Media Uploader](#). Leave this field blank if you want to show the default logo.png image from /images/ folder of the theme.

Favicon URL You can upload your own favicon image (16x16px) via [Media Uploader](#). Leave this field blank if you don't want to display a favicon.

RSS Feed URL If you want to use Feedburner to track your RSS readers, insert your Feed Address here. Example: <http://feeds2.feedburner.com/wpzoom>. Leave it blank if you want to use the standard WordPress Feed.

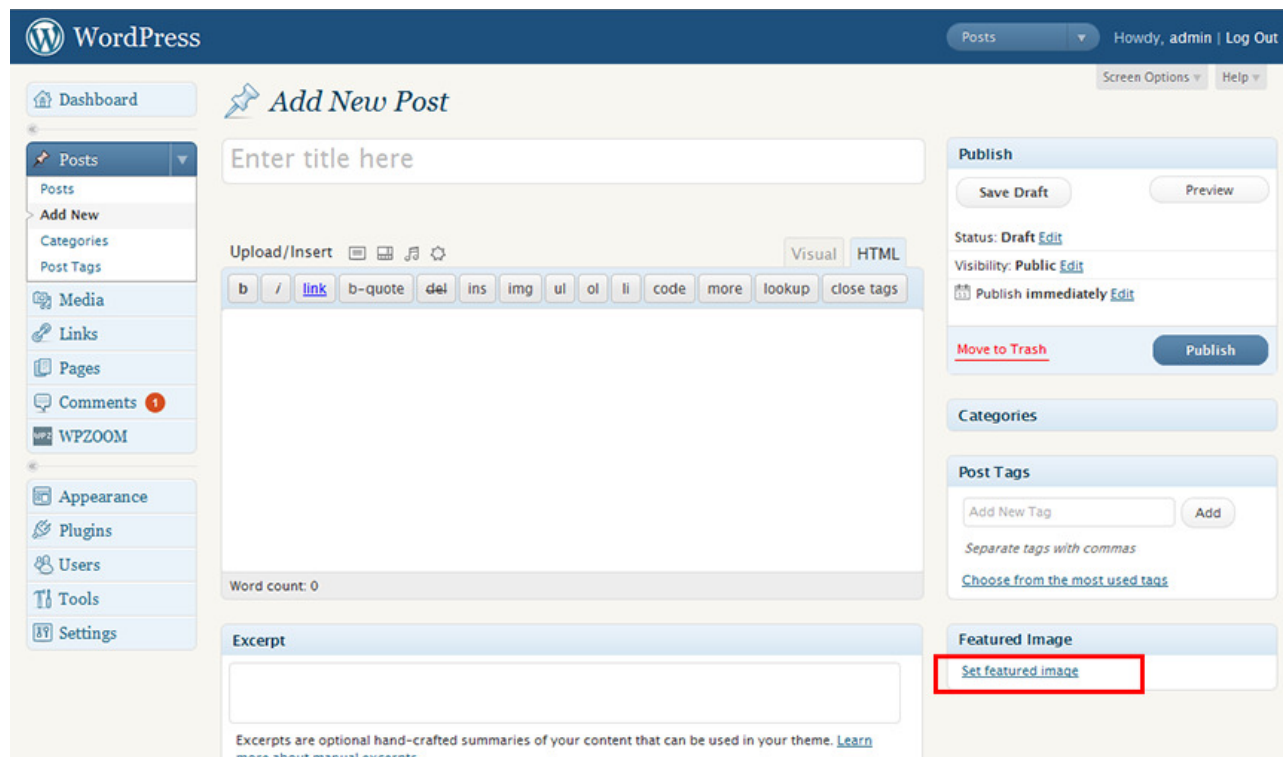
HOW THUMBNAILS SYSTEM WORK?

Since the release of WordPress 2.9 we have implemented the "Post Thumbnails" feature, which allows you to manually what image to use as a post's thumbnail.

When adding/editing a post, on the right side you will see a box: **Featured Image**.

Click on it, upload an image and then click the **"use as featured image"** button.

If you don't upload such a thumbnail, the theme will automatically try to use as a thumbnail the first image found in the post's content body.



If no image will be selected as Featured Image, then the theme will pull the first image from articles content to be used as thumbnail.

FILE PERMISSIONS

MANIFESTO Theme uses the **TimThumb** PHP script for dynamic image resizing in some parts of the theme.

Set file permissions **777** (rwx-rwx-rwx) to:

/wp-content/themes/manifesto/scripts/

and

/wp-content/themes/manifesto/scripts/cache/

Otherwise TimThumb images resize script will not work properly.

Some important things to note:

1. **TimThumb** requires the **GD library**, which is available on any host server with PHP 4.3+ installed.
2. On some hosts **TimThumb** will work with **755** permissions (rwx-rx-rx). On other hosts, you need to set 777 only to the /cache/ folder, while keeping 755 permissions for the /scripts/ folder.
3. If you are hosting your site with **HostGator**, [take a look at this thread](#) to solve the TimThumb issue:

4. TimThumb requires that you use images hosted on the same domain, so you cannot insert(hotlink) images from other sites. You have to upload them to your site first.

SIDEBARS & UNIQUE WIDGETS

MANIFESTO THEME has one sidebar for placement of Widgets.



MANIFESTO THEME has 3 unique specially developed widgets:

1. WPZOOM: Gallery

This widget will show a certain number of photos from a Flickr RSS Feed, your own or some other feed. Just set the full URL to the RSS and select the amount of photos. Photos will appear 3 in a row.

2. WPZOOM: Featured Posts

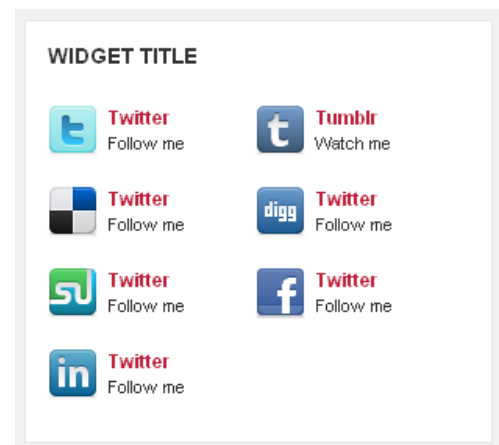
This widget will show a certain number of posts from a selected category. Should be placed in the Sidebar, not in the footer.

3. MANIFESTO: Social Connections

This widget will show links to your profiles on popular social sharing/networking web-sites.

Can be placed in Footer and in Sidebar.
